Management Plan Review (Day 1 & 2)

MPSA Exam/Concept Evaluation (Day 3)

Upon completion of the concept evaluation, you will be presented with case study information about a property. You will have approximately 6 hours to review and analyze the case study. The practical application is open book.

MPSA Exam/Practical Application (Day 4)

Presented with a management scenario, you will work independently to prepare written essay answers to a series of questions that follow the IREM management plan outline. The questions are designed to measure your ability to analyze and communicate complex information needed to complete a workable management plan. this practical application is open book.
